CRITERIA:

There are five different classes of individual membership including Fellow, depending upon the candidate's qualification, experience, age, position in the field of Welding which are as follows. There is separate application for Fellowship.

MEMBER	Member shall be a person, aged over 28 years, i) having Engineering Degree or its equivalent or Post Graduate Degree / Diploma in Applied Science / Technology and also having experiences in the field of welding or its allied subjects for a minimum period of 5 years; OR ii) the persons with Degree / Diploma in Engineering having experiences in the field of welding or its allied subjects and is an Associate Member of the Institute for at least 10 years are also eligible to apply for upgradation to Member; OR iii) an Associate member of the Institute for a minimum period of 5 years, who have passed the AM-IIW Examination.
ASSOCIATE MEMBER	Associate Member shall be a person, i) having passed AM-IIW Examination or having a Graduate Degree in Engineering or having Post Graduate Degree / Diploma in Science & Technology and interested in welding and related technology; OR ii) having Diploma in Engineering with a professional experience for at least 5 years and interested in welding and related technology.
ASSOCIATE	Associate shall be a person possessing educational qualification approved by the Council and any other person interested in Welding Technology and Science and in allied processes approved by the Council and craftsman skilled in the art of welding with such qualification or registration as the Council may approve.
STUDENT	Student shall be a person, not having reached the age of 25 years, studying Engineering Degree / Diploma course in an Educational Institution and approved by the Council. No person shall remain a student after his 28 th birthday.

Photocopies of the certificates for highest Technical and Professional qualifications, proof of age, experience, photo ID, address proof and any other document the applicant likes to produce in support of his application should be enclosed.

By-law 7: All members (other than Honorary Members) shall pay annual subscriptions, which are due and payable on election and thereafter on the 1st day of April in each year.

By-law 9: Until otherwise determined by the Council, Entrance Fee shall be payable in accordance with the class of membership.
